Abstract guidance:

- All abstracts will be reviewed by members of the Organising Committee and assigned to the appropriate session for an oral and/or poster presentation.

Preparing and Formatting an Abstract

- Abstracts can only be submitted online using the Abstract form for oral and/or poster presentations available above.
- Abstracts must be submitted in English
- No references, tables or graphics should be included in the abstract
- For authors, please use this format : 1st author, presenting author et al
- When using abbreviations within the body of the abstract, please spell out the name in full at first mention and follow with the abbreviation in parenthesis.
- It is the responsibility of the author to ensure abstract text does not contain any typos or grammatical errors.
- No changes can be made after the abstract deadline has passed.

Oral presentations

Short talks

These are expected to last 10 minutes with 5 minutes Q and A; one presenter per abstract submitted

Flash talks

These are expected to last 3 mins and should comprise of no more than 3 ppt. slides with minimal animations

Poster presentations

Posters will be on display at the event - please print posters A1 portrait only.

As this is an interactive event, it is expected that the author of the submitted poster will register and attend the event to be available to discuss the research with fellow delegates during scheduled poster sessions
